Pennsylvania State Police Troop M to Participate in “Click it or Ticket”

Bethlehem, PA – The Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) Troop M will be participating in the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration’s (NHTSA’s) “Click it or Ticket” campaign from Monday, May 11, 2026, through Sunday, May 31, 2026.

Troopers will be proactively patrolling the roadways focusing on any violation of the Commonwealths occupant restraint laws.
